Volunteer-Led Programs

- JA volunteer(s) facilitate the program activities adding their industry knowledge and perspective to the lessons
- Programs are offered in-class, virtually or live as permitted
- Teacher manages access and supervises students during the program
- Timing and duration of program is flexible

Teacher-Led Programs

- Teachers can facilitate the program activities and lessons directly with their students or monitor their students while they work independently
- JA will provide support and access to the program resources
- Teachers can lead the program at their own pace
- Instructonal time is four hours + optional business pitch competition



Key Learning Objectives

After completing the program, students will be prepared to:

- Develop a business plan and strategy for an entrepreneurship venture
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- Identify products or services they can take to market
- Determine their competitive advantage and define a target market
- Use resources that are available to help them move forward with their entrepreneurial dreams
