Over a four-month period, JA's Company Program teaches grade 10-12 students how to organize and operate a real business. Volunteers from the local business community work with students to launch and run a small enterprise. This gives students the real-world skills and experience that they need to achieve their dreams of becoming entrepreneurs.

Volunteer-Led Programs

- JA volunteer(s) facilitate the program activities adding their industry knowledge and perspective
- Programs are offered virtually or inperson as permitted
- Duration is flexible but typically runs weekly for 1-3 hours for 4-6 months (after school)

Teacher-Led Programs

- Teachers can facilitate the program activities and lessons directly with their students or monitor their students while they work independently
- JA will provide support and access to the program resources through the JA Campus
- Teachers can lead the program at their own pace
- This program is normally run throughout the semester



Key Learning Objectives

After completing the program, students will be prepared to:

- Solve real business challenges
- Gather data, evaluate choices and create a business plan
- Launch a business and raise capital for start-up
- Develop and market a product or service
- Work in a team environment
- Maintain and analyze financial records
- Set sales goals and make effective sales pitches
