

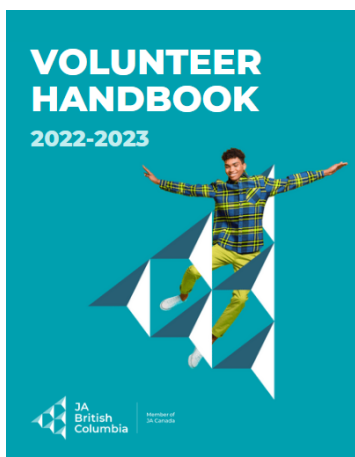


VOLUNTEERING IN A SCHOOL CLASSROOM

Join your host teacher and students in their school classroom. JABC will provide all the necessary printed and digital program materials..

Quick Tips:

- Ensure you know the school's location and give yourself ample travel time. If you are running late, please notify your Program Manager.
- Plan to arrive at the school at least 10-15 minutes early.
- Sign in at the school office and make your way to the classroom.
- Program materials kit: If you have received the kit before your delivery, please bring it with you to the school. If not, the kit will be waiting for you in the classroom.
- With the host teacher's help, set up the computer, projector and speakers.
- Load the classroom presentation. This may have been sent to the host teacher ahead of time, may be on a USB in the program kit, or may require downloading from the [JABC website](#).
- Test the videos; ensure they play, and sound is working.
- Ask your host teacher if there are any students who may have challenges or require extra support.
- Hand out the student workbooks and tent cards.
- Have fun and remember the teacher is there to help you. Just ask!
