Students will learn about investing and have the opportunity to develop and test their own financial strategies online through a six week Stock Market simulation.

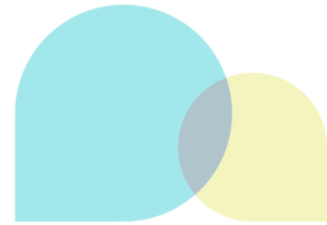
Learning Experience Highlights of the Investment Strategies Program
