#### **Business of Our Own**

#### Grades 6-8 (4 hours)

Students gain hands-on experience in business planning using a model canvas to identify their product, target market, and resources. An optional in-school sale or pitch presentation enhances the learning experience.

#### Grades 7-9 (4 hours)
