Brian Hill is the founder of Aritzia, a global fashion retailer he started in Vancouver in 1984 alongside his family. Over the years, he has grown the company into a major player in the industry, with more than 110 boutiques across North America and a robust eCommerce platform. Under his leadership, Aritzia has become a publicly traded company with a market value of \$3 billion and annual revenues surpassing \$2 billion.

Brian's impact goes beyond Aritzia's growth. He has shaped the careers of over 60,000 employees and is known for his expertise in operations, creative direction, and corporate strategy. His leadership has earned him accolades, including the Fraser Institute Founders' Award in 2022 and the Distinguished Retailer of the Year award in 2012. In 2024, he was inducted into the Business Laureates of BC Hall of Fame.
