#### **HISTORY**

The Business Laureates of British Columbia (BLBC) Hall of Fame was created by JA British Columbia (JABC) in 2005 to honour British Columbia business leaders whose efforts have shaped our province and country. With Barbara Brink and Jim Shepard as the founding cochairs, the Hall of Fame stands as a testament to the positive legacy the Laureates provide to future generations of business leaders.

#### HALL OF FAME SITE

The BLBC Hall of Fame site is prominently located in the Vancouver Convention Centre West and includes a specially-commissioned sculpture, Shape of Inspiration, designed by B.C. artists Cheryl Hamilton and Michael Vandermeer.

A media display allows visitors to learn more about each of the members of the Hall of Fame.


