**Provided Resources:** Classroom presentation, interactive digital resources, and a physical kit or resources for activities/games\*



## What will students do and learn?

- Identify the role of money in everyday life
- Play a board game to earn money for a business start-up scenario
- Match their interests to potential business ideas
- Create a business plan for a start-up
- Engage in hands-on games, including a board game on repaying a business loan and a bingo-style math activity





One of my favourite parts of the program is the Business Board Game. The students track their money inflows and outflows using a Money Tracking Journal, and things get competitive fast. It's fun, energetic, and where some of the best learning happens.
